



Dear Woodbury City School Community,

Yesterday evening March 24th, we were informed that a member of our staff had tested positive for the coronavirus. This staff member was present in our Chromebook Distribution for families and students on March 17th and 18th, in the Cap Paine Gymnasium. However, they were not directly involved in the distribution process. As a result, we have been in contact with the Gloucester County Department of Health who has informed us that anyone who was in contact with this person, in their medical opinion, is at low risk for contracting this illness. In the event of this news we have contacted all staff members who may have been in close contact with this individual. This correspondence is to inform the greater Woodbury school community, particularly those who picked up Chromebooks for their children. We are encouraging those who were present on either March 17th or March 18th to take the necessary precautions moving forward, most notably, staying indoors and self-quarantining for 14 days if possible, due to limited but potential exposure.

In addition, we have closed all of our district buildings effective today March 25th at 1pm until further notice. Food service will still be available for pick-up, please check the website for dates, times and location.

The safety of our staff, students and community is paramount to our organization at this time and our goal is to keep everyone safe. Please continue to practice social distancing to lessen the curve of infection, wash your hands frequently and reach out to your physician if you become symptomatic.
