My child left items at school, how do I get them?

We will be setting a schedule for pick up and drop off of school/personal belongings in each respective building in Early June. The dates for each school are below. Stay tuned for specific details from your building principal.

- West End – June 4th & 5th
- Walnut - June 8th & 10th
- Evergreen – June 9th & 11th

I have school materials at home how do I return them? (books, instruments, safety belts, etc.)

We will be setting a schedule for pick up and drop off of school/personal belongings in each respective building in Early June. Stay tuned for specific details from your building principal.

How do we return the Chromebook and hotspot we borrowed?

Students will be keeping their computers home for the summer, and returning them to school in September. This includes the 5th graders who will bring their computers to the junior high school for collection there.
