



Class of 2020 Graduation Options

Woodbury Junior-Senior High School has been working closely with all stakeholders in creating a memorable graduation experience for our seniors. Below are three options families can choose for this years' festivities.

Option 1- In person graduation with two family members and graduate. Location: Woodbury Junior-Senior HS Football Field

Date: June 1

Rain Date: June 2

Families will have the opportunity to cross the stage with their graduate wearing their cap and gown, pick up their diploma cover, and have a photo taken that will be sent to an e-mail address for download. This walk will be recorded and included as part of the virtual graduation ceremony. Specific dates and times for this option will be provided via a phone call in the coming days.

Option 2: Families will have the opportunity to record their own celebratory graduation scene at home! In the virtual graduation ceremony, a senior portrait will be on one side of the screen and a family video (15 second max – videos will be edited if they exceed this time limit) of the graduate in their cap and gown will be on the other side. Graduates choosing this option will be provided the link for upload during the above-mentioned phone call.

Option 3: Graduates not interested in either Option 1 or 2, will have their senior photo shown during the virtual graduation ceremony when their name is called.

For those senior families that choose Option 1:

- The school will call you to schedule a time slot on June 1
- Time slots will be every 15 mins with two families scheduled per time slot
- The graduate along with two family members should arrive on Wood St. at the scheduled time and drive to the very end of the road near the stadium
- The graduate should remain in the car with the windows closed. Staff will be there to alert you when it is your turn to exit the vehicle.
- Woodbury City Police will be present to assist

- Graduate should arrive dressed in cap and gown
- Once given the green light by staff, the graduate and their two family members (there will be no exceptions to this rule) may exit their car and walk along the track towards the stage. Masks do not need to be worn at this time.
- The graduate's name will be called and they may walk across the stage and pick up their diploma cover
- The graduate will walk off the stage and proceed to another station on the football field where a group family photo will be taken by staff. A link to all pictures will be provided to students after the event
- Once the picture is taken, the graduate and their two family members will proceed to the third station where they will receive a senior gift bag from the Project Graduation committee
- The group then exits back to their car along the other side of the track
- Once the group is back in their car, they pull out and return home
- The next graduate drives down in line and the cycle repeats
