Dear Woodbury Families,

UPDATE – Yesterday, May 27, the Department of Education released a broadcast outlining the directive on high school graduation ceremonies. These guidelines presently do not include an increase in the amount of people allowed at an outside gathering (25), however with this guidance we will move our 'modified in-person' graduation ceremony for high school seniors to Wednesday, July 8 (***Rain date – Thursday, July 9***). This date will be structured similarly to our plans for the virtual ceremony previously scheduled for June 1. This will allow for us to make any adjustments in accordance to any new guidelines set forth by the Department of Education and the Governor's Office.

If the powers that be increase the number of persons allowed to gather outdoors to a minimum of 300 people by Friday July 3, we will quickly convert to a more traditional graduation ceremony. (***July 8 with a July 9 rain date***).

The district is committed to finding the best possible way to honor our class of 2020 graduates. We appreciate your continued patience and support in this endeavor.
