- Our teachers and specialists are fully credentialed, well-trained and experienced. Our staff members have advanced degrees and specialty certifications.

Our school includes an expansive library space and vast collection of resources, as well as a sensory motor room, art room, and beautiful gym. Every classroom has a SMART Board and tablets for student use, as well as ample supplies of books and hands-on learning materials.

Creative Curriculum® provides the foundation and guide for all classroom learning experiences.

The early childhood program integrates language and literacy with science, math, music, art, social studies, and physical development based on the *Illinois Early Learning Standards*. Our early childhood certified staff facilitates learning through hands-on experiences and purposeful play. Activities promote the development of social/emotional, motor, cognitive, and language skills within nurturing classroom communities.

The curriculum is taught through integrated units of study. Lessons and activities within each unit are experiential. Progress is assessed regularly through observational data collection to ensure our students are meeting the standards in all domains.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to volunteer in our classrooms and school.

On-Site Extended Care Options

Early Bird Extended AM Care:

The Early Bird program is staffed and administered by Elizabeth Meyer School. The hours are **7:00 to 8:30 a.m.**

Skokie's Place for All Children in Extended Care (**SPACE**) offers care for students after AM and before PM Classes, as well as in the late afternoon. SPACE is administered and staffed by the Skokie Park District. Separate registration is required.

Extended Preschool SPACE

- "Extended Preschool" morning: 8:30 to 12:00 p.m. For PM section students who need full day care.
- "Extended Preschool" afternoon: 11:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. For AM section students who need full day care.

Late Afternoon SPACE (beyond Extended Preschool):

▼ 2:30 to 6:00 p.m. Participating Kindergarten students are joined by late afternoon preschoolers following the 2:30 p.m. dismissal
