### **Instructional Assignments**

#### Class Size

The class size shall be considered the number of students under the jurisdiction of a teacher at any one time.

The Board's guidelines for class size to the administration is designed to maintain classes for the regular upper grades (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>) at 25 to 30 students, for the regular intermediate grades (4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>) at 23 to 28 students, for the regular primary grade (3<sup>rd</sup>) at 21 to 25 students, and for the regular primary grades (Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup>) at 18 to 23 students.

The most important factor in determining class size is the number of students, but other criteria will be considered also. This policy will be administered pursuant to 6:212-AP.
