6:212 Instructional Assignments

Class Size

The class size shall be considered the number of students under the jurisdiction of a teacher at any one time.

The Board's guidelines for class size to the administration is designed to maintain classes for the regular upper grades (7th and 8th) at 25 to 30 students, for the regular intermediate grades (4th, 5th and 6th) at 23 to 28 students, for the regular primary grade (3rd) at 21 to 25 students, and for the regular primary grades (Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd) at 18 to 23 students.

The most important factor in determining class size is the number of students, but other criteria will be considered also. This policy will be administered pursuant to 6:212-AP.
