Class Size

The class size shall be considered the number of students under the jurisdiction of a teacher at any one time.

The Board's guidelines for class size to the administration is designed to maintain classes for the regular upper grades (7^{th} and 8^{th}) at 25 to 30 students, for the regular intermediate grades (4^{th} , 5^{th} and 6^{th}) at 23 to 28 students, for the regular primary grade (3^{rd}) at 21 to 25 students, and for the regular primary grades (Kindergarten, 1^{st} , and 2^{nd}) at 18 to 23 students.

The most important factor in determining class size is the number of students, but other criteria will be considered also. This policy will be administered pursuant to 6:212-AP.
