

Authorization to Pick-up for Middleton and Meyer

Authorization to Pick-up Student from School or at Bus Stop

In District 73.5, our schools are dedicated to guarding the safety of each of our students. Our staff is prohibited from releasing any student to a person who has not received prior authorization from a parent or legal guardian.

Parents are automatically authorized to pick up their own child, unless there is a documented legal reason which prevents them from doing so. In such case, legally documented proof must be presented to the school office.

By checking authorized to pick-up, you have agreed that this person is allowed to pick up your child from school. We will not release a child to anyone not authorized for pickup. No one under age 18 is eligible for pick-up.

By signing off, you have attested that you are the legal parent/guardian of the student. You understand that Middleton and Meyer schools will not allow any person, other than parents/guardians and those listed as an "authorized contact" to pick up your child at school.

For Meyer, this also applies to pick-up at the bus stop. You further agree to be at school at the appointed time to pick up your child. For Meyer, you understand that the anyone picking the child up at the bus stop must be an "authorized contact" and that you agree to be at the bus stop at the appointed time to pick up your child.
