

JUNIOR/SENIOR HIGH CAMPUS FACT SHEET

- Office hours are 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., (summer hours: 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.), Monday through Friday.
- Supervision begins at 7:30 a.m. in the cafeteria. Students may go to lockers at 7:50 a.m. The school day begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 2:55 p.m. (Students whose transportation has not arrived by 3:30 p.m. will be sent to After School Care, a.k.a. After School Chill, and fees will apply.)
- **Campus morning drop off and afternoon pickup** can be hectic at the start of the school year. **Please view the [Traffic Flow Video](#) online and/or the [Traffic Flow Map](#) to keep any confusion to a minimum. (www.cincinnatichristian.org, Parents section, Junior/Senior High Resources tab, then Traffic Info tab.**
- **“Delayed Start”** school days begin at 10:15 a.m. Dates for delayed starts are the website under the Parents tab, then Junior/Senior High Resources tab.
- All **exam days are early dismissal days**, ending at 11:45 a.m. A parent-signed permission form is required for students to leave campus earlier than noon on these days. Students not leaving campus by noon on exam days will attend a supervised study hall until 2:55 p.m. Students who remain after this time will be asked to go to the After School Care and appropriate fees will be charged.
- **After School Care** (a.k.a. After School Chill) is available from 3:30 – 6:00 p.m. with applicable fees. (Please see After School Care Policies and Procedures with Application if interested.)
- **Chapel** takes place every Wednesday. Parents are always welcome. (Times may vary for some special guest speakers or concerts, which is rare but possible, so please check with the school first.)
- **Student assemblies** are usually every Tuesday and Thursday afternoons and **homerooms** are usually each Monday.
- All **students parking** on campus property during school hours will require a Student Parking Permit. Students purchasing a permit will be assigned a parking space and permit tag to be displayed in their front windshield. A parking permit can be purchased at any time during the school year.
- A **hot lunch program** is offered daily with no pre-order requirement. Meals range from \$3-\$5. Chick-fil-A takes the place of the usual hot lunch menu on Thursdays only, \$3-\$5. Vending machines with drinks, sandwiches and healthy snacks are also available. (Prices vary.)
- **Haiku** (CCS learning management system) and **RenWeb** (CCS student information system) are the most important communication tools for parents. Please see the Computer System/Software Registration and Update Instructions for details about each system, “Parents” section of the website, “Haiku/RenWeb” tab.
- Please see the Student Activity Permission Form for details about your student(s)’ opportunities to go off campus.

- **Senior High Physical Education** (9th through 12th grades only):
 - A two-week Summer P.E. Session can be taken for credit in place of one of the in-school P.E. courses. Fee varies. Contact Ken Peters if interested at ken.peters@cincinnati-christian.org.
 - Alternate P.E. (participation in CCS Athletics) is an option that can be used in place of an in-school P.E. course. Contact the Guidance Office for specific criteria.
