The play is composed of true experiences shared by veterans and Mr. Miller himself, who served as a Navy chaplain. The production is about two Navy chaplains, one a veteran of Vietnam and one a veteran of the conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan, who are sharing their memories of service and ministry. Their stories come to life as they talk, and we meet the people they ministered to and the people who shaped their stories. As these two chaplains tell their stories, we see their passions, struggles, and scars that have left a mark on their hearts. Ultimately, the theme of true peace and coming to the table of peace, which has military and ministry meaning, guides the journey these two chaplains take down memory lane. Therefore, the play is titled *Table of Peace*.

The stories of *Table of Peace* come from the lives of American Veterans and cover the range of life led by those veterans. While not graphic, the content of this production may not be suitable for young children or wounded veterans still seeking recovery from what they may have experienced. It is not our intention to re-open old wounds. Veterans and families should use discretion where children and wounded hearts are concerned.
