# Health/Safety Measures

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- Symptom screening
  - ◆ Self-screening at home
  - ◆ Daily temperature checks on-site
- Students exhibiting symptoms at school
- Quarantine procedures
- Communication to families and Health Department



# Health and Safety Measures

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## → Our ASK to families:

- ◆ Conduct **symptom screenings daily** before school
- ◆ **Do not send students to school who show ANY signs of symptoms**
- ◆ Exercise **flexibility** through mandatory quarantines
- ◆ Respond to contact tracing calls from the Department of Health
- ◆ **Practice social distancing and avoid large gatherings**



## Health/Safety Measures

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- Procedures for visitors to the building (limited access)
  - ◆ Any visitor **must wear face-mask** and have temp taken on-site
  - ◆ Visitors **asked to wait in vestibule**; encouraged to call where possible
- Drop off student at Main Office doors; please do not accompany inside
- If dropping off items, place in **vestibule box and label with student name**
- **Forgotten lunches** should be dropped off by **10:00 am**
- We will **NOT be able to accommodate pre-ordered lunches** and deliveries this year



# Health/Safety Measures

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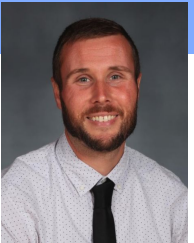
→ **Picking up** student:

- ◆ Please schedule appointments outside of school hours
- ◆ If unavoidable, please **email office staff** on the morning you intend to pick up your child early
- ◆ **Call front office** when you arrive in parking lot; child will meet you at your car
- ◆ If parent is not picking up child, please indicate name of person in morning email. Staff will ask for ID when driver arrives

# Arrival Procedures

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→ **Morning** arrival

◆ Bus

- Pickups begin at **8:35 am** and will arrive no later than **9:25 am**

◆ Drop offs, bike riders, and walkers

- Begin entering the school

→ Temperature checks

◆ Let's all exercise **flexibility**

→ Student remain in their classroom or homeroom until **9:30 am**



# Dismissal Procedures

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- **Bus dismissal** will occur **first**
  - ◆ Students will be dismissed **one** bus at a time
  - ◆ Students will **exit** the building **through the same door they arrived**
  - ◆ Students will have the **same assigned seat** in the afternoon as they did in the morning
- **Parent Pickup** will begin **after** the last bus is called
  - ◆ **Placards - 2 per** family (**MUST** have the placard to pick up a student)
  - ◆ Picking up students outside of the household

# Student Schedule Update

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- We are SO close!!!!

- **Reminder:** Eagles @School will remain with the same cohort of students all day in their assigned homeroom location.

# World Language Instructional Update

- **K - 5:** Asynchronously as a quarter long rotation
- **6 - 8:** Asynchronously all year long
  - ◆ All **French** students will learn with and receive feedback from **Madame Grambo**
  - ◆ All **6th grade and ½ of 7th grade Spanish** students will learn with and receive feedback from **Señora Lucas**
  - ◆ All **8th grade and the other ½ of 7th grade Spanish** students will learn with and receive feedback from **Señora Mann**



## Eagles @Home Curriculum Materials Pick-up

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- Pick-up will take place on **Wednesday and Thursday, 8/19-8/20**
- All of our @Home students will have access to the same curriculum materials as our @School students
- Will be similar to pick-up of devices from this summer

  - ◆ Traditional letter grade (A-F) in grades 7 and 8

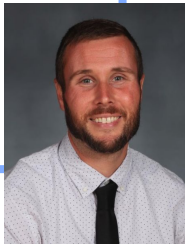


# Attendance
