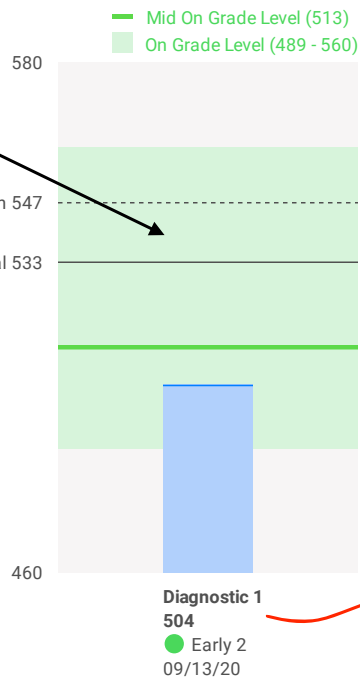
## Diagnostic 1
