You MUST bring your signed permission slip with you on the day of your auditions (see attached).

All participants in the act must be present at the auditions and have an act name picked out. This act name will be listed on the OG website if it makes the show. The act name can be changed at a further date.

Acts cannot exceed 2:00 minutes. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Practice in advance and time your act.

Music must have appropriate words, costumes, and movements.

You must bring your music with you to the tryout. It can be on a phone, flash drive, or on a CD.

Lip syncing is not allowed. Background music must be instrumental only--NO WORDS! If you are doing a vocal performance the lyrics must be taken out.

All acts that make it are subject to modifications made by the directors.

Auditions will be held in the small gym. Please arrive 10 minutes before your audition time with all music, props, etc. that you will need. We will call your name at the time of your audition. If your scheduled time is late in the day, please feel free to go home after school and return later.

Your act should be show-ready. We will ONLY take acts that are prepared and rehearsed.

We HIGHLY recommend working with a parent to help you perfect your act before tryouts. Remember: What is funny to you may not be funny to others. Our audience ranges in age from 3-90.

If you are in 8th grade and in an act of four or more people, you will be allowed to try out for a second act.
