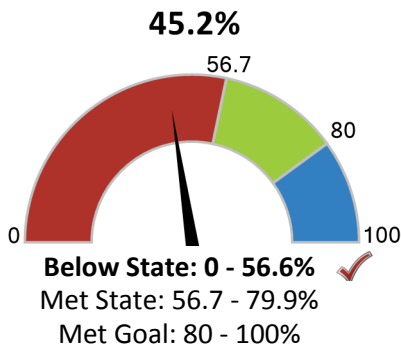
School Highlights Reported by the District

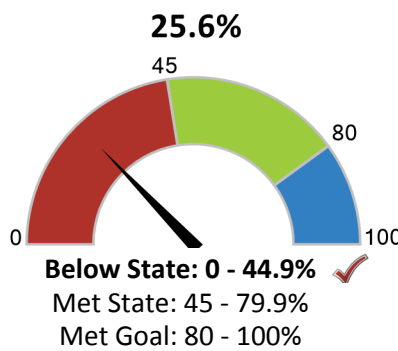
How did students perform on assessments?

English Language Arts



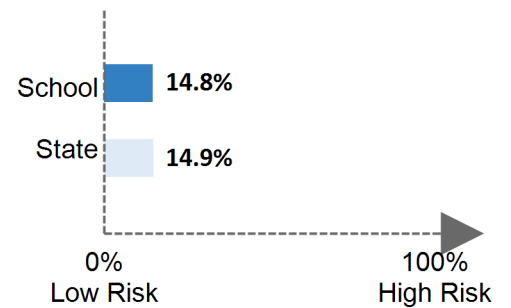
Math



Are students at risk?

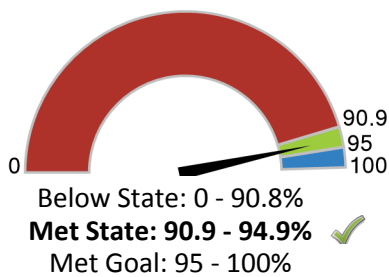
Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled
