

Halsted Middle School Extra-Curricular Eligibility

A student, to be eligible for participation in co-curricular activities at Halsted, must meet the eligibility requirements of the Halsted Middle School as approved by the Newton Board of Education.

If a student is failing one course at the midpoint or end of a marking period, he/she will be on academic probation and will be ineligible to participate in extra-curricular activities until his/her marks are reviewed.

However, if the student shows improvement in his/her academic achievement as shown by weekly proficiency reports, consideration to participate on a weekly basis may be granted by the administration. Student is responsible for:

1. Obtaining progress reports from his/her teacher or the guidance counselor.
2. Having these forms completed by **all** of his/her teachers.
3. Giving these reports to the assistant principal for consideration.

Restrictions:

Students may not participate in school sponsored extra-curricular activities on a day when the student has been absent from school or arrives at school later than **11:00 a.m.** Exceptions to the above may be granted by the principal or assistant principal in special situations. Suspensions will lead to loss of privilege of participating in a school-sponsored activity. If a student fails more than one course for a second grading period he/she becomes **INELIGIBLE** to participate in any co-curricular activity. In the event that a student fails one or more course for the year, he/she becomes **INELIGIBLE** to participate in any co-curricular activity the following year pending review of the first marking period.
