During your scheduled screening time, come and meet the Preschool team! The team will engage with you and your child across various domains, lasting for approximately 20 minutes. Additionally, Pennoyer's EL teacher will guide families through the completion of the Home Language Survey.



Additional, in-person screening may be scheduled if needed once Governor Pritzker's Stay-at-Home order is lifted.
