- 1) Copy of the signed certification for the \$10.9 million bond sale referendum appearing on the November 2020 ballot, aka the "resolution providing for and requiring the submission of the proposition of issuing School Building Bonds to the voters of School District Number 79, Cook County, Illinois, at the general election to be held on the 3rd day of November, 2020" and any responses from the state and / or county confirming receipt of the resolution
- 2) Any and all documents showing the estimated cost to property owners per dollar of assessed value for the same bond sale referendum in item #1
