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NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
Pulaski Community School District

NOTICE is hereby given that the meeting of the School Board of the Pulaski Community School District will be held on Wednesday, May 17, 2017, at 6:00 PM at the District Office Meeting Room, 143 West Green Bay St. Pulaski WI.

The School Board of the Pulaski Community School District will hold a regular School Board meeting on May 17, 2017. Public notice for this meeting and the meeting agenda is published and posted separately, as required by Board policy and state statutes. The following additional notice is provided, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0133(3), which requires at least ten (10) days' notice of a meeting at which a local governmental unit intends to consider and, if appropriate, accept a proposal to negotiate an energy savings performance contract. The information contained in this notice shall be reprinted as part of the regular Board meeting notice and agenda for the May 17, 2017, meeting, upon issuance.

In accordance with Wis. Stat. § 66.0133, the School Board of the Pulaski Community School District hereby gives public notice that it intends to consider and/or approve a proposal for an energy savings performance contract for the implementation of energy conservation and facility improvement measures to reduce operating costs for the District. H&H Energy Services, Inc. has been identified as a potential interested party to the proposed performance contract, and other qualified providers may also submit proposals. Therefore, the School Board shall consider awarding and/or shall, subject to finalization of contract terms, approve a proposal for an energy performance contract that includes the following energy conservation and facility improvement measures: HVAC Systems, lighting systems, building ventilation, selective roof and window replacements, and water conservation measures at each of the district's buildings. The energy efficiency measures shall be performed with a guarantee that the resulting utility and operational savings will equal or exceed the cost of such projects within the useful life of each facility.

At the meeting, the School Board shall review and evaluate the bids or proposals submitted by all bidders and may award the performance contract to the qualified provider that best meets the needs of the Pulaski Community School District. Any such award will be subject to subsequent Board approval of a performance contract.
