- Over \$1 million of scholarships given to seniors each year

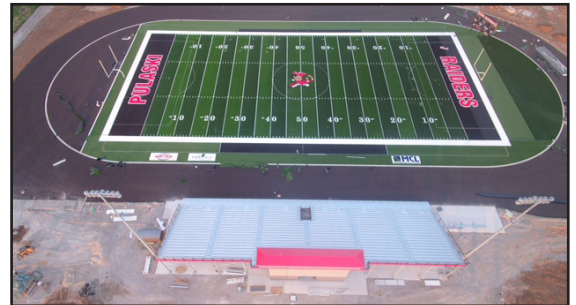


EXTRACURRICULARS
