<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To check the status of students and programs</li> <li>• To inform others about students</li> <li>• To gather evidence after learning</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To improve and influence learning while in progress</li> <li>• To inform students about their learning</li> </ul>
<b>Primary Users</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Policy makers</li> <li>• Administrators</li> <li>• Teachers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students</li> <li>• Teachers</li> </ul>
<b>Focus</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accountability of expected standards and benchmarks for schools and teachers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Achievement targets that enable students to build and improve toward standards</li> </ul>
<b>Place in Time</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Event after learning</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Process during learning</li> </ul>
<b>Teacher’s Role</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Administer the test</li> <li>• Interpret and use results to help students meet standards</li> <li>• Interpret results for parents</li> <li>• Assign grades</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transform standards into classroom targets</li> <li>• Inform students of targets</li> <li>• Build classroom assessments</li> <li>• Adjust instruction based on results</li> <li>• Involve students in the assessment process</li> </ul>
<b>Student’s Role</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strive for the highest score and avoid failure</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use results in their learning to do better the next time</li> </ul>
