PCSD's Student Services:

- Offers a continuum of special education services and focuses on providing student programming with general education peers, with the general education curriculum whenever appropriate.
- Offers K-12 Oneida language to students as well as many Native American cultural experiences.
- Offers comprehensive school counseling curriculum at all schools
- Offers grades 6-12 academic career planning

Student Services also provides professional development to staff, including :

- suicide prevention resources;
- child abuse prevention training;
- life-threatening allergies education; and
- medication administration.
