

Pulaski High School will be using the computer software program called ImPact (Immediate Post Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing).

This baseline result – in the event of a head injury – can then be used by the qualified medical professional of your choice to assess whether or not a concussion has occurred and what treatment decisions should be made.

The computerized exam for the baseline is a non-invasive “video game” format which tracks memory, reaction time, speed, and concentration. The test takes about 30 minutes to complete - but allows up to 45 minutes... about 10-15 minutes for the registration of the test and about 30 minutes for the actual test.

All athletes, regardless of which sports season(s) they plan to participate in, will take the test prior to their first sports season. Pulaski school's licensed athletic trainer will be available to answer any questions you may have.

The baseline ImPact test will need to be complete prior to the athletes first day of practice. Athletes will take the baseline test every other year, usually their freshman and junior year.

The health and well – being of our student – athletes is of utmost importance to us.
