Welcome Back to the 2018-19 school year! Hopefully, it was a wonderful, restful summer. This past Wednesday, students in grades 1st through 8th have started to participate in the fall NWEA MAP assessment. Grade 1 will just take Mathematics. Grades 2-8 will take two assessments: Reading and Mathematics. The testing window will occur on various days from August 22 through September 12. PROCEDURE FOR CALLING YOUR STUDENT OUT FOR AN APPOINTMENT

Notify the health office at 847-400-8908 no later than the "morning of the planned appointment" in one of three ways:

1. Have your student bring a note from a parent to the health office before school starts at 8:30 am. It would be helpful to include the reason the student will be out of school, what time the student is to be picked up in the main office for sign out for the appointment, and if the student is expected to return to school that day.
2. Call the nurse directly before 9:00 am with all of the above information.
3. Leave a detailed message on the health office answering machine any time after 3:30 pm and before 8:30 am. An authorized adult must come into the school or attendance office to sign out a student. No children are allowed to leave the building unescorted.

SIXTH GRADE LUNCH

Sixth grade students will sit with their advisories for the first couple of weeks of school. This temporary assignment will help reduce stress and make sure that everyone has someone to sit with and talk to during the lunch period. Sometime after Labor Day, the students will have the opportunity of sitting wherever they choose.

We are making significant progress on our state of the art Maple School. It has been fascinating to watch over the summer. We ask that you continue to be careful navigating around the parking lot during construction. Thank you!

STUDENT DROP-OFF/PICK UP

During the school year, students will not be permitted to enter the building until 7:40 a.m. Student drop-off and pick-up are located along the curb on the east, south and west sides of Maple School building only. There is NO drop-off/pick-up in the bus turnaround on Shermer Drive, or at the GBN parking lot. The bus only drive is located on Sherman Drive outside of the MultiPurpose Room. Parents should not enter the bus lane, nor block the bus lane.

After drop-off/pick-up, parents should continue to drive around the building and exit onto Sherman Drive (the north side of the building). Parents dropping off students at the Sherman Road entrance must turn right; if they wish to exit south, they can continue west and go through the Maple parking lot. All students may enter the building through the hallway doors near Maple's main office, Entrance A, and the Multi-Purpose Room, Entrance K. Music students should proceed to their classroom. All other students should proceed directly to the Multi-Purpose Room if they have no pre-arranged meeting.

MAPLE SOCCER 2018 - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Maple Athletic Department is excited to announce that Wood Oaks Junior High School has graciously agreed to provide outdoor practice space for our upcoming soccer seasons. All 7th and 8th grade practices will be held at Wood Oaks Junior High School - 1250 Sanders Road, Northbrook, IL 60062. With the New Maple School construction efforts continuing, we sincerely appreciate everyone's patience and effort in making this a reality for our student-athletes. With that being said, it will be the responsibility of each family to provide transportation to all clinics, tryouts and practices.

We understand that many parents work and may not be able to arrange for individual rides to Wood Oaks. If you are not able to provide transportation to your individual student-athlete, we ask that you develop carpools at your discretion. Each student-athlete's parent or previously agreed upon carpool groups will also be responsible for students being picked-up at the conclusion of all practices at Wood Oaks. Coaches will remain with all Maple student-athletes as outlined in our athletic coach's handbook for the safety of all our student-athletes, but please be respectful to their time and families by arranging appropriate pick-up times. The aforementioned transportation requirements follow the same process we use with our 6th grade basketball teams when they have practiced at Willowbrook and/or Wescott in the past. No coaches are allowed to drive students to or from Wood Oaks and coaches will not be returning to Maple after practices.
