

Extra-Curricular Activities Code of Conduct Agreement

At Maple School, we believe that extracurricular activities are an integral part of student growth. We encourage every student to participate and establish a commitment to academics as their first priority. The following is a list of guidelines that Maple School students and their parents are expected to follow in order for students to participate in school-sponsored activities. This list is not intended to be all inclusive, and any acts committed that are illegal, or that, in the opinion of the Maple School staff, reflect poorly upon Maple School or District 30 may be subject to consequences.

To ensure that students and families are aware of this Code of Conduct, please read and review this document. This signed document must be completed prior to the first day of tryouts. All statements are presented in student form, but parents are also agreeing to the outlined expectations, along with agreeing to help support their student(s) as necessary.

- ❖ I will work toward and demonstrate the standards and habits of success. The coach, sponsor or supervisor will monitor my academic progress and if they observe that I am not working toward meeting standards and/or habits of success, I will be required to develop an improvement plan with the appropriate teacher(s). The plan will be monitored by the coach, sponsor or supervisor and if at any time I do not perform satisfactorily regarding my part of the plan, I will be subject to the agreed upon consequences until I do meet the expectations in the improvement plan and/or my grade(s) demonstrate working toward standards and/or habits of success.
- ❖ I will be current with all required coursework.
- ❖ I will actively display the SIX Pillars of Character Counts! (Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Citizenship, Caring) throughout the school day, at practices, and at events.
- ❖ I will attend practices, rehearsals, and events unless excused by the coach, sponsor or supervisor.
- ❖ I will check the schedule carefully before trying out, and I will discuss attendance conflicts with the coach, sponsor or supervisor before the tryout date.
- ❖ I will have a current physical on file with the school nurse prior to the first day of tryouts. It is the student and parent's responsibility to check with the school nurse prior to tryouts to make sure the student's physical is on file and up to date.
- ❖ I will provide necessary medical information to my child's coach/sponsor.
- ❖ I will dress appropriately on all event days as explained by the coach, sponsor or supervisor.
- ❖ I will respect and follow all directions from the coach, sponsor or supervisor and abide by all team/squad/club rules and eligibility requirements.
- ❖ I will access and regularly check the team/squad/club website prior to contacting the coach, sponsor, or supervisor (this includes contacting the Athletic Director).
- ❖ For Athletics, I will follow the expectations outlined in the Maple Student Handbook, on the Athletics Website, and be sure to contact the coach of the sport prior to contacting the Athletic Director or administration with any questions or concerns.

- ❖ I understand that contacting the Athletic Director or any member of the administrative team is the final step concerning any issue within the Athletics' Department (please see the Parent-Coach Communication Document for more details).
- ❖ I understand that school attendance is mandatory on the date of events to participate in the activity. In the event of an appointment, or family emergency, participation will be approved at the discretion of the coach, sponsor, supervisor, or Athletic Director and administration. If I am absent as the result of an illness, I understand that I cannot participate.
- ❖ To ensure my safety, I understand that if I am unable to participate in Physical Education coursework, then I am also unable to participate in extracurricular activities that include a physical movement.
- ❖ I understand that each coach, sponsor or supervisor has the prerogative to establish additional rules pertaining to the activity supervised, which do not conflict with this Code of Conduct. Such rules may include attendance at practices, dress and general conduct at practice, events, and on bus trips. All additional rules/expectations will be presented to students prior to the beginning of the activity. Parents will be notified at their individual teams/clubs parent meeting with the coach, sponsor, or supervisor.
- ❖ I understand that failure to meet these obligations will result in consequences ranging from student conferences to removal from practices or removal from the team, club, or squad.
- ❖ I understand that attendance from parents at their student's team(s) parent meeting is mandatory and missing this meeting is subject to removal of their student from the team. This meeting is held to reduce issues during the season. Please read the parent-coach communication document on the Athletics Website for more information.

The aforementioned guidelines are in effect for the duration of the extra-curricular activity and consequences for infractions are cumulative. I agree to participate in extracurricular activities with adherence to the Maple School Code of Conduct.
