

Albion Central School District -- Universal Pre-Kindergarten Program
Bus Arrangement

The district can provide transportation for your child, or you may transport your child on your own. Because pre-kindergarten is a ½ day program, transportation is different than the regular school day run. The session a child will attend depends upon the bus route. The “pick up” and “drop off” information on the transportation form is what is used to determine the route the bus will take. Please read the following information carefully.

Morning (AM) session students are picked up on the normal morning elementary run. They are transported home on vans that will normally bring your child home between 11:30 – 12:30 p.m. (mid-day).

Afternoon (PM) session students are picked up mid-day on a van which will normally arrive between 11:40 and 12:40 p.m. Students will then take the elementary bus run home at 3:30 p.m.

The mid-day runs are limited by bus size and length of routes, therefore, we can not change the routes once they are established in July. You will need to provide a mid-day drop-off or pick-up location that will be used all year. The session your child will attend is directly related to his/her pick-up and drop-off locations.

Once your child has been assigned to a bus and/or an AM or PM session it can NOT be changed.
