Students in Grades 4 through 8 will be provided with registration information for each of the optional activities as they occur during the school year. Payment will be due at that time. No refunds will be made for students who drop out of an activity or for activities missed due to student or staff scheduling conflicts, holidays, illness, or school closings. No student is required to participate in any of these programs.

**STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE**, purchased by District 90, covers your child for injuries incurred while participating in school sponsored and supervised activities, including all sports.
