ADAMS ELECTRIC EXPANDS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Dear Doug,

Thank you for all you do in our schools to promote scholarship opportunities to your senior class. Adams Electric Cooperative has been offering scholarships to sons and daughters of our members since 2008 and has continued to try and grow the offerings of this program.

Beginning in 2019, we are excited to announce a few changes. While your schools' seniors will still be eligible to apply for the chance for a \$1,000 one-time scholarship, a second opportunity will also now exist. All families who reside on Adams Electric's power lines in Adams, Cumberland, Franklin, Perry and York counties (32,000 accounts) and have a senior preparing for either a college or career path after graduation now have options!

NEW THIS YEAR **

Adams Electric will award a \$1,000 scholarship to eight high school seniors with plans to attend a post-secondary career or trade school. **This scholarship program specifically benefits pursuits of vocational-technical school students who must become accepted in educational programs leading to certificates/degrees related to building/construction trades, cosmetology, culinary arts or vehicle technology.**

Any interested high school senior residing in Adams Electric's service territory **MUST** apply online through the Adams County Dollars for Scholars (DFS) web portal at www.adamscountydfs.org to be considered for this scholarship, **regardless of school affiliation**. Applicants will create a login and personal profile on the website to apply. Applications must be submitted between *Jan. 1, and April 6, 2019*, to be considered. Recipients will be nominated by the Adams County Community Foundation Dollars for Scholars selection committee, on behalf of Adams Electric. 
(Option B) Adams Electric will continue to award a \$1,000 collegiate scholarship to one high school senior each who attends Bermudian Springs, Biglerville, Big Spring, Chambersburg, Fairfield, Littlestown, New Oxford, Northern and Shippensburg; as well as up to five \$1,000 scholarships to high school seniors attending a cyber, private, home school or other public school in upper Franklin, lower Cumberland, Adams or southern and western York county. These applicants MUST apply online through the Adams County Dollars for Scholars (DFS) web portal at www.adamscountydfs.org. Each applicant will need to create a login and personal profile on the website to apply. Applications will be accepted between Jan. 1, and April 6, 2019. Recipients will be nominated by the Adams County Community Foundation Dollars for Scholars selection committee, on behalf of Adams Electric. (For questions using this application, please email adamscountydfs@gmail.com.)

We hope you will ask your seniors during any contacts you may have with them who provides electric service to their home and if the answer is Adams Electric, encourage them to apply for a continuing education scholarship – **either** collegiate or career and trade! Your assistance in promoting these scholarships will make this year of change a success and bring more scholarship monies to local graduating seniors.

We appreciate the job you do in our schools and thank you for your help promoting our Adams Electric scholarship programs.

Also, as a reminder – don't forget you are encouraged to **recommend two members of your junior class to attend the National Rural Electric Youth Tour** each year in Washington, D.C. Remember that these students DO NOT have to be the child of a cooperative member. Any high school junior is eligible to apply for an interview and be considered for this all-expense-paid trip selection (\$2,000 value). We need your student's contact information by mid-December; interviews will take place in late January!
